Note: for wind speeds under 5 miles per hour, there is no significant wind chill factor and for wind speeds above 45 miles per hour the wind has no further appreciable effect.

## Wind Chill / Frostbite Guidelines

30° F or greater, Chilly, Generally unpleasant.

15° F to - 30° F Cold. Unpleasant.

- 0° F to -15° F Very cold. Very unpleasant.
- 0° F to 20° F Bitter cold. Frostbite possible.
- 20° F to 60° F Extremely cold. Frostbite likely. Outdoor activity becomes dangerous.
- 60° F or less Frigidly cold. Exposed flesh will freeze within 30 seconds.
