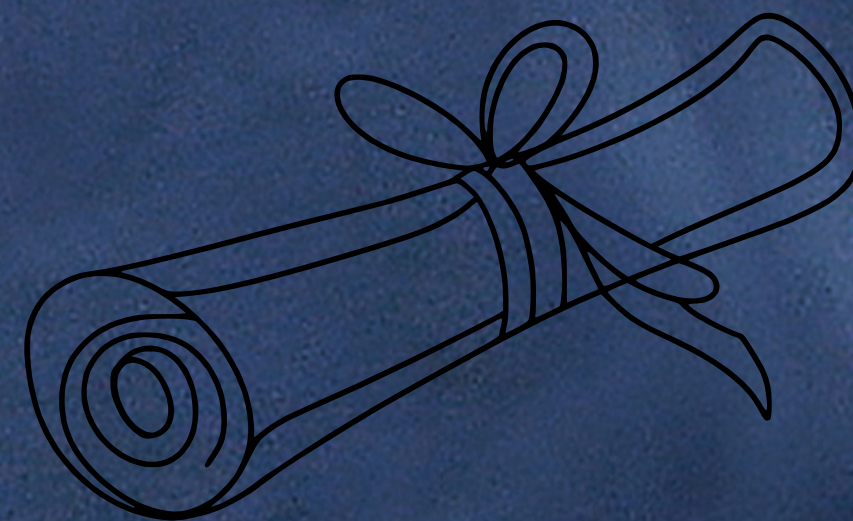

THE ABC'S OF GRADUATION



A IS FOR ATTENDANCE



If the students are not at school, they are not getting the opportunity to participate in class, earn grades and learn.



B IS FOR BEHAVIOR

Positive behavior in school leads to a better school climate which leads to better outcomes overall.



C IS FOR CURRENT GRADES

Making sure a student is on top of their grades and holding themselves accountable leads to course completion.



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Credits- Students must earn a minimum total of 22 credits in specified subjects.

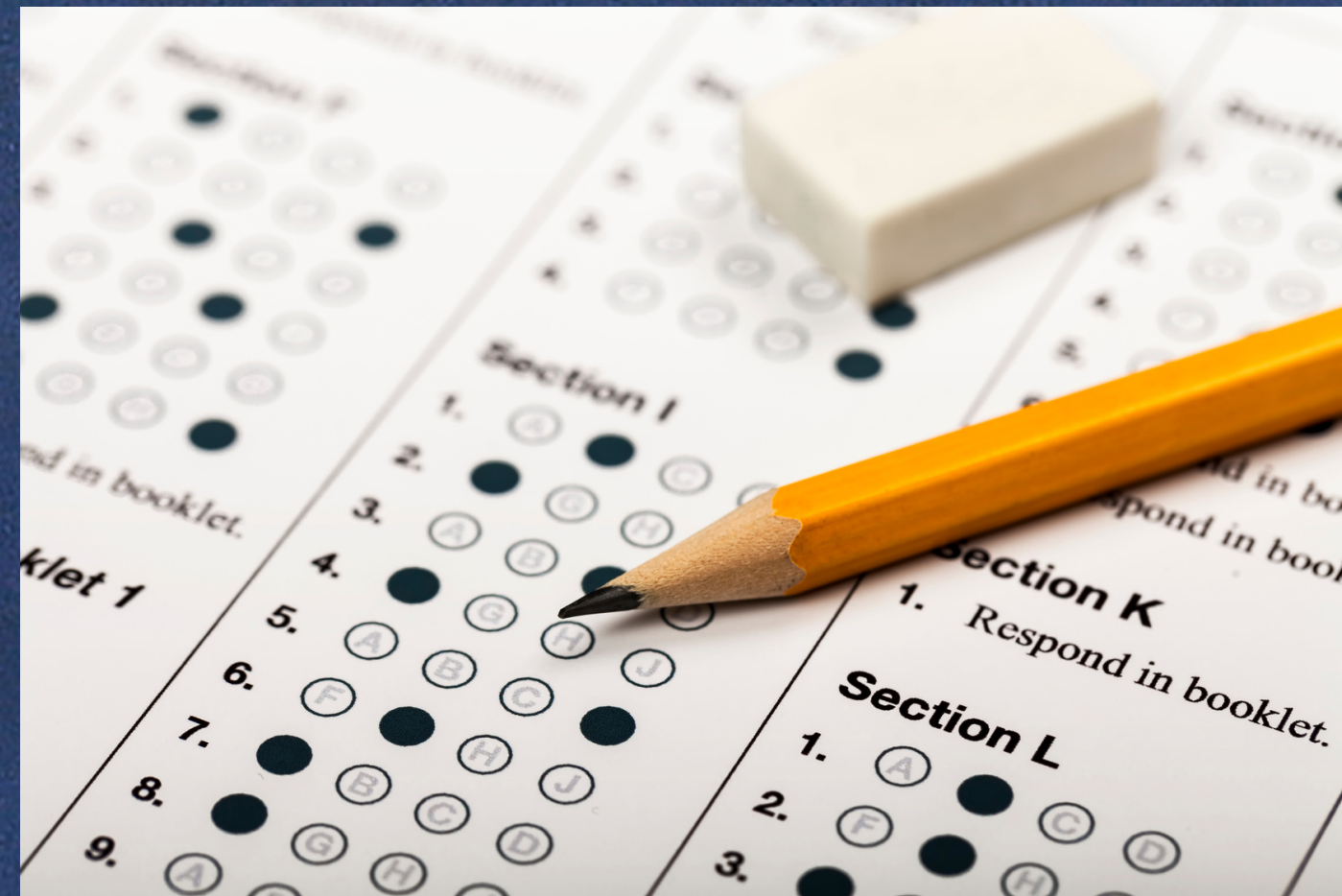
General Course Requirements	Minimum Requirements

Other (PE, Health, Art)	2
Electives	6

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Competency: Students can demonstrate competency by earning a passing score (684) on Ohio's high school Algebra I and English language arts II tests.

Scored a 684 or higher on the Algebra I Ohio State Test

Scored a 684 or higher on the English 2 Ohio State Test



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Readiness: Students can meet the readiness requirement by earning two diploma seals. Students should choose seals that align with their goals and interests. These seals give students the chance to demonstrate academic, technical, and professional skills and knowledge that align with their passions, interests, and post-high school pathway.

COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS

Ohio College Credit Plus (CCP) Orientation 2025

- Dual-credit program for students in grades 7-12; allows earning college credit while completing high school requirements. (~80,000 students participating annually)
- Course Registration & Pathways
 - Courses selected based on assessment scores, prerequisites, and graduation requirements.
- Schools/colleges offer 15- and 30-credit hour pathways to help plan course loads.
- Course Types & Delivery Modes
 - Transferable courses, tech certificates, foreign language, anatomy & physiology, etc.
- • Course delivery: online; or on college campus.
